## **ARTICLE SUBMISSION GUIDE**

# **Authors and Responsibilities of the Augustine University Journal of Social Sciences (AUJSS)**

## **Language**

The language of the manuscript must be in English (either American or British standard, but not the mixture of both).

## **Length of paper**

The length of the paper should not exceed 15 pages (including footnotes and references). Articles should be typed in 1.5 line space 1" margins. Authors are advised to write as concisely as possible, but not at the expense of clarity.

## **Title Page**

Title page is a separate page before the text. It should include the following information:

### **Title**

Title should be concise and informative. It should avoid abbreviations and formulae where possible.

### **Author's names and affiliations**

Authors' names must be clearly stated with surname coming first. Authors' institutional affiliation addresses should follow under the names. Full postal address of each affiliation should be provided including the country of each author. All that is required is the E-mail address, and telephone number of the corresponding author.

### **Corresponding author**

Articles with more than one Author should clearly state the corresponding author. Therefore, correspondence at all stages of review, publication and also post-publication will be routed to that author. Telephone numbers (with country and area code) should be provided in addition to the e-mail address and the complete postal address.

### **Acknowledgement of Sponsors**

In the case of articles which emanated from funded project full acknowledgement of the funding agency should be indicated.

### **Abstract**

A concise and factual abstract is required (maximum length of 150 words). The abstract should state briefly the purpose of the research, the principal results and major conclusions. References should be avoided.

### **JEL Classification and Keywords**

All articles submitted must include at the end of the abstract all relevant JEL Classification. For more

information on JEL Classification, visit <https://www.aeaweb.org/jel/guide/jel.php> . The AUJSS does not make use of keywords.

### **Subdivision of the article**

Article should be divided into clearly defined and numbered sections. Sections should be numbered 1, 2, 3, etc and Subsections should be numbered 1.1, 1.2, 1.1 & 2.2, etc. The abstract should not be numbered.

### **Table and Figures**

Tables and figures are to appear at the appropriate location within the text where they are being discussed and not at the end of the article. Please note that figures, pictures, diagrams and tables must be in black and white.

### **References**

Author(s) should follow the latest edition of APA style in referencing. Please visit <https://apastyle.apa.org/> to learn more about APA style

### **Citations in the text**

Please ensure that every reference cited in the text is also present in the reference list (and vice versa). No citation is required in the abstract. Unpublished results and personal communications should not be in the reference list, but may be mentioned in the text. Citation of a reference as 'in press' implies that the item has been accepted for publication.

### **Reference List**

References should be arranged first alphabetically and then further sorted chronologically if necessary. More than one reference from the same author(s) in the same year must be identified by the letters "a", "b", "c", etc., placed after the year of publication. All cited references in the body of the article must be listed in the reference list. Examples: Reference to a journal publication: Nwokoma, N. I, Adewuyi, O.A. and Omotor, D.G. (1800). Impact of scientific study. *Journal of Scientific Communications*, 163 (1), 51-59. Reference to a book: Stone, K.L. and Black, G. S. (1970). *Note to Authors*. (2nd ed.). New York: Macmillan, (Chapter 4). Reference to a chapter in an edited book: Kilian, L. (2010). Oil price shocks, monetary policy and stagflation. In: Fry, R., C. Jones and C.K. Kent (eds.) *Inflation in an Era of Relative Price Shocks*. Sydney: Reserve Bank of Australia, pp.60-84. Reference to a web source: Langdana, F.K. (2009). *Macroeconomic policy: Demystifying monetary and fiscal policy*. Springer Science+Business Media. DOI: 10.1007/978-0-387-77666-8\_1.

### **Submission Preparation Checklist**

Before submitting the manuscript, author(s) should check the following list. The submission has not been previously published, nor is it before another journal for consideration. The submission file is in Microsoft Word file. Manuscript has been made in the light of Journal's author guidelines. Author(s) did not mention his or her name and affiliation in the main text. Author(s) has read all the terms and conditions of the journal.

### **Copyright and Access**

Copyrights for articles published in AUJSS are retained by the publisher. In case of plagiarism, it is the author's responsibility to bring an infringement action if so desired by the author.

# Submission, Peer-Review and Publication Process

A full double-blind peer review process is used that comprises of the following steps.

- Paper is sent to 2 reviewers for review. The reviewers' recommendations determine whether a paper will be accepted / accepted subject to change / subject to resubmission with significant changes / rejected.
- For papers which require changes, the same reviewers will be used to ensure that the quality of the revised paper is acceptable.
- If the paper is accepted by the reviewers, author(s) will be notified to pay the author fee.
- Upon payment, the paper will undergo copy editing, and galley proof is sent to the corresponding author for final correction (if any)
- Acceptance letter will be provided after the payment has been made.
- Author/Corresponding Author will be notified about the possible date of publication.
